THE COLLEGE'S MANAGEMENT HEREBY ANNOUNCES THE SALE OF ADMISSION FORMS TO SUITABLY QUALIFIED CANDIDATES SEEKING ADMISSION INTO FULL TIME.

HIGHER NATIONAL DIPLOMA (HND), NATIONAL DIPLOMA (ND) AND CERTIFICATE COURSES FOR THE 2022/2023 ACADEMIC SESSION. THE PROGRAMMES ARE ENUMERATED AS FOLLOWS:

DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH

A. Diploma in Community Health (DCH) – (Duration: 6 Semesters)

<u>Entry Qualification:</u> Candidates seeking admission into Diploma in Community Health (DCH) referred to as CHEW must possess five (5) credit passes at SSCE (WAEC, NECO or GCE Ordinary Level (O/L)), at not more than two sittings, which must include: English Language, Mathematics, Biology/Health Science, Chemistry and Physics.

B. Junior Community Health Extension Workers (JCHEW) – (Duration: 4 Semesters)

Entry Qualification: Candidates seeking admission into Junior Community Health Extension Workers (JCHEW) must possess three (3) credits and two (2) passes at SSCE (WAEC, NECO or GCE O/L) at not more than two sittings. The three (3) credits must include: English Language, Mathematics, Biology/Health Science, and two (2) passes from any other subjects.

NOTE: The programme (A and B) are accredited by the Community Health Practitioners Registration Board of Nigeria (CHPRBN), Abuja.

C. National Diploma in Community Health (NDCH) – (Duration: 6 Semesters)

Entry Qualification: Candidates seeking admission into National Diploma in Community Health (NDCH) must possess five (5) credit passes at SSCE (WAEC, NECO or GCE Ordinary Level), at not more than two sittings, which must include: English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

NOTE: This programme is accredited by the National Board for Technical Education (NBTE), Kaduna. Candidates applying for this course must attempt 2022/2023 JAMB/UTME and score at least 120 marks.

D. Higher National Diploma in Community Health (HNDCH) – (Duration: 4 Semesters)

Entry Qualification: Candidates seeking admission into Higher National Diploma in Community Health (HNDCH) must possess the qualifications as in "A" above plus a National Diploma in Community Health with at least Lower Credit from a recognized College of Health Technology in Nigeria.

NOTE: Graduates of Higher National Diploma in Community Health are mobilized for NYSC. This programme is accredited by the National Board for Technical Education (NBTE), Kaduna.

DEPARTMENT OF PHARMACY TECHNICIAN TRAINING

A. Certified Pharmacy Technician – (Duration: 6 Semesters)

Entry Qualification: Candidates seeking admission into Certified Pharmacy Technician (CPT) programme must possess a minimum of five (5) credit passes at SSCE (WAEC, NECO, NABTEB or GCE O/L). Other equivalents are not accepted. The credit passes must include: English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics. Successful graduands will be awarded a Certified Pharmacy Technician Certificate which will qualify them to read Pharmacy in the University at 200 Level in accordance with the University Guidelines for their degree programme in Pharmacy.

NOTE: This programme is accredited by the Pharmacists' Council of Nigeria (PCN), Abuja.

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH INFORMATION MANAGEMENT (HIM)

A. National Diploma in Health Information Management (ND HIM) – (Duration: 6 Semesters)

<u>Entry Qualification:</u> Candidates seeking admission into National Diploma in Health Information Management (ND HIM) must possess five (5) credit passes at SSCE (WAEC, NECO or GCE O/L), at not more than two sittings, which must include: English Language, Mathematics, Biology or Health Science, Chemistry or Physics and one subject from Economics, Geography, Agriculture Science, Christian Religious Knowledge or Nigerian Language.

NOTE: This programme is accredited by Health Record Officers' Registration Board of Nigeria (HRORBN), Abuja.

DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

A. Environmental Health Technology (EHT – ND/HND) – (Duration: 8 Semesters)

Entry Qualification: Candidates seeking admission into Environmental Health Technology (EHT) must possess five (5) credit passes at SSCE (WAEC, NECO, NABTEB or GCE O/L), at not more than two sittings, which must include: English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

B. Environmental Health Technician (EVT) – (Duration: 6 Semesters)

<u>Entry Qualification:</u> Candidates seeking admission into Environmental Health Technician (EVT) must possess three (3) credit passes at SSCE (WAEC, NECO or GCE O/L), at not more than two sittings, which must include: English Language, Biology or Health Science, Chemistry or Geography, Physics and Mathematics.

C. National Diploma in Public Health Technology (NDPHT) – (Duration: 6 Semesters)

Entry Qualification: Candidates seeking admission into National Diploma in Public Health Technology (NDPHT) must possess five (5) credit passes at SSCE (WAEC, NECO or GCE O/L), at not more than two (2) sittings, which must include: English Language, Biology or Health Science, Chemistry and Physics. Environmental Health Assistant Certificate (with CGPA not less than 2.50) from an accredited programme/Institution shall also be considered for admission.

D. National Diploma in Epidemiology and Disease Control Technology (NDEDCT) – (Duration: 6 Semesters)

Entry Qualification: Candidates seeking admission into National Diploma in Epidemiology and Disease Control Technology (NDEDCT) must possess five (5) credit passes at SSCE (WAEC, NECO or GCE O/L), at not more than two (2) sittings, which must include: English Language, Mathematics, Biology or Health Science, Chemistry, Physics and Geography. Environmental Health Assistant Certificate (with CGPA not less than 2.50) from an accredited programme/Institution shall also be considered for admission.

NOTE: This programmes (A, B, C and D) are accredited by West African Health Record Examination Board (WAHEB), Lagos; Environmental Health Officers' Registration Council of Nigeria (EHORECON), Abuja; and National Board for Technical Education (NBTE), Kaduna.

<u>DEPARTMENT OF DENTAL SURGERY TECHNICIAN</u>

A. Dental Surgery Technician (DST) – (Duration: 6 Semesters)

Entry Qualification: Candidates seeking admission into Dental Surgery Technician (DST) must possess four (4) credit passes at SSCE (WAEC, NECO or GCE O/L), at not more than two sittings,

which must include: English Language, Mathematics, Biology or Health Science and Chemistry. Successful candidates are awarded the Dental Surgery Technician Certificate.

NOTE: This programme is accredited by Dental Therapy Registration Council of Nigeria (DTRCN), Lagos.
